Community

We know how hard it can be to stay motivated when you are searching for work, especially when you're on your own. That's why we've designed every CAP Job Club to be a relaxed place where you'll meet other people in similar situations, who understand what you're going through and will support and encourage you along the way.



Course

We'll also help to equip you with the practical tools you need to find work. Our eight-session course walks members through each step of the job hunting process – from identifying your strengths and skills, right through to writing a great CV and learning how to succeed in an interview.



Coaching

You'll have the opportunity to gain one-to-one informal support from a dedicated Job Club Coach. They'll spend time helping you to set goals, identify any areas you're struggling with, and tackle them head on.
